Speed Sign

The speed sign is up and running. It had to be installed close to the office first so I could connect to it for training purposes. The sign will be moved around throughout the municipality over the next few months. As identified in previous council discussions, the sign will be moved to the Skiff Lake area next and then to Debec. Councillors can email the office with suggested locations for the sign.

Post for Signs

I was able to order the metal posts from the same company we purchased the speed sign from. They should be here sometime this week or next. Once they arrive, Charles Gould will install the cottage lane signs.

Municipal Office Renovations

The contractor is scheduled to begin renovations Monday, May 12. There will be some additional cost above the proposal quote that council approved. These items were listed on the RFP scope of work but were not included in the approved proposal.
