Voyent Alert is an innovative alerting system that provides critical information about emergencies such as severe weather, road conditions, public health notifications, and other important community updates. This “notification system” is designed to keep our community informed and safe. Residents will have access to timely, personalized notifications ensuring you receive the information you need, when you need it.

How to Sign up: It’s simple, FREE and takes less than a minute. You are able to chose how you receive notifications using one OR all of the options below:

- Mobile App: Download the Voyent Alert app from the Apple Store or Google Play Store
- Text Message: Register to receive SMS alerts
- Email: Sign up to get email notifications
- Voice Mail: Opt in to receive voice alerts
